## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY/GENERAL INFORMATION

- The age of horses & ponies entering the Rising Star Led Classes is in accordance to the following:
  - 2 year old horses & ponies – born between 1-08-2015 and 31-07-2016
  - 3 year old horses & ponies – born between 1-08-2014 and 31-07-2015
  - 4 year old horses & ponies – born between 1-08-2013 and 31-07-2014
  - 5 year old horses & ponies – born between 1-08-2012 and 31-7-2013
- All exhibitors must be members of Equestrian Australia
- Entry forms must be completed in full
- There will be no stabling available unless the horse/pony is competing in another class at DJWTS. There are ample yards available.
- Each horse/pony must display a bridle number during the class. The number will be provided by the OC, however each exhibitor must supply their own bridle number holder.
- Winners from each class will be eligible to re-present at the end of all classes for the crowning of *“Rising Star” Overall Champion Horse* and *“Rising Star” Overall Champion Pony*
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to amalgamate classes if insufficient entries are received.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to split classes 1-4, depending on entries
- Colts & Stallions must wear the green stallion discs or green bridle numbers at all times, as per EA rules.
- Exhibitors attire is not judged, but we encourage you to wear suitable tidy casual clothing that allows you to run your horse out to the best advantage
- All entries will be required to include 3 generation pedigrees and details of any breed society registrations. This information may be used publicly for this event.
- Horses/Ponies are judged on conformation, paces and overall type.
- A workout will be provided to each exhibitor prior to the event

## **Stabling**

- Unfortunately, there will not be enough stables to cater for those horses or ponies participating in the "Rising Star" Led Classes, unless they are competing in other classes at DJWTS. There are enough yards that can be used.

## **Dogs**

Werribee Park National Equestrian Centre Committee of Management considers it a privilege that you are allowed to bring your dog to this venue. Dogs must be kept on a leash and under effective control at all times and are not permitted in the indoor arena at any time

## **Catering Facilities**

## **Exercising of Horses/Bridle Numbers:**

- Two bridle numbers (as per listed competition number in program/draw) must be worn, one on each side of the horse (either on bridle or saddle cloth) at all times whenever the horse is out of the stable. Riders will need to supply their own numbers
- Stallions are required to wear EA green stallion discs or green bridle numbers at all times when horse is out of stable

## **Swabbing:**

- Random swabbing will take place throughout the event
- Competitors whose horses have been selected for sampling will be instructed by an official to present their horse immediately to the box prepared for the purpose, and must comply with such official's instructions. A steward will accompany the horse and rider to the swabbing box

## **Liability:**

- Riders and/or owners whose entries have been accepted will undertake to indemnify the Organising Body against all claims, losses, suits, and damages made against or suffered by the Organising Body by reason of any negligent act or omission on the part of any rider, trainer or attendant whilst he is attending, riding or otherwise handling a horse and agrees that act or omission on the part of such rider or attendant found in any action against the Organising Body to be negligent, shall be deemed to have been negligent for the purpose of any claim under this indemnity

**Competitors please note:**

- Late or incomplete entries will not be accepted
- Any horse not accepted on the reserve list will receive a full refund
- Any horse accepted on the reserve list will be charged the compulsory administration fee
- Scratchings/Withdrawals - 50% of entry fee (excluding administration fee) will be refunded on receipt of a medical or veterinary certificate, submitted to DJWTS – Equestrian Victoria, 400 Epsom Rd, Flemington 3031 within 3 days of the event
- Stable & camping fees will be refunded in full upon presentation of medical or veterinary certificate within 3 days of the event

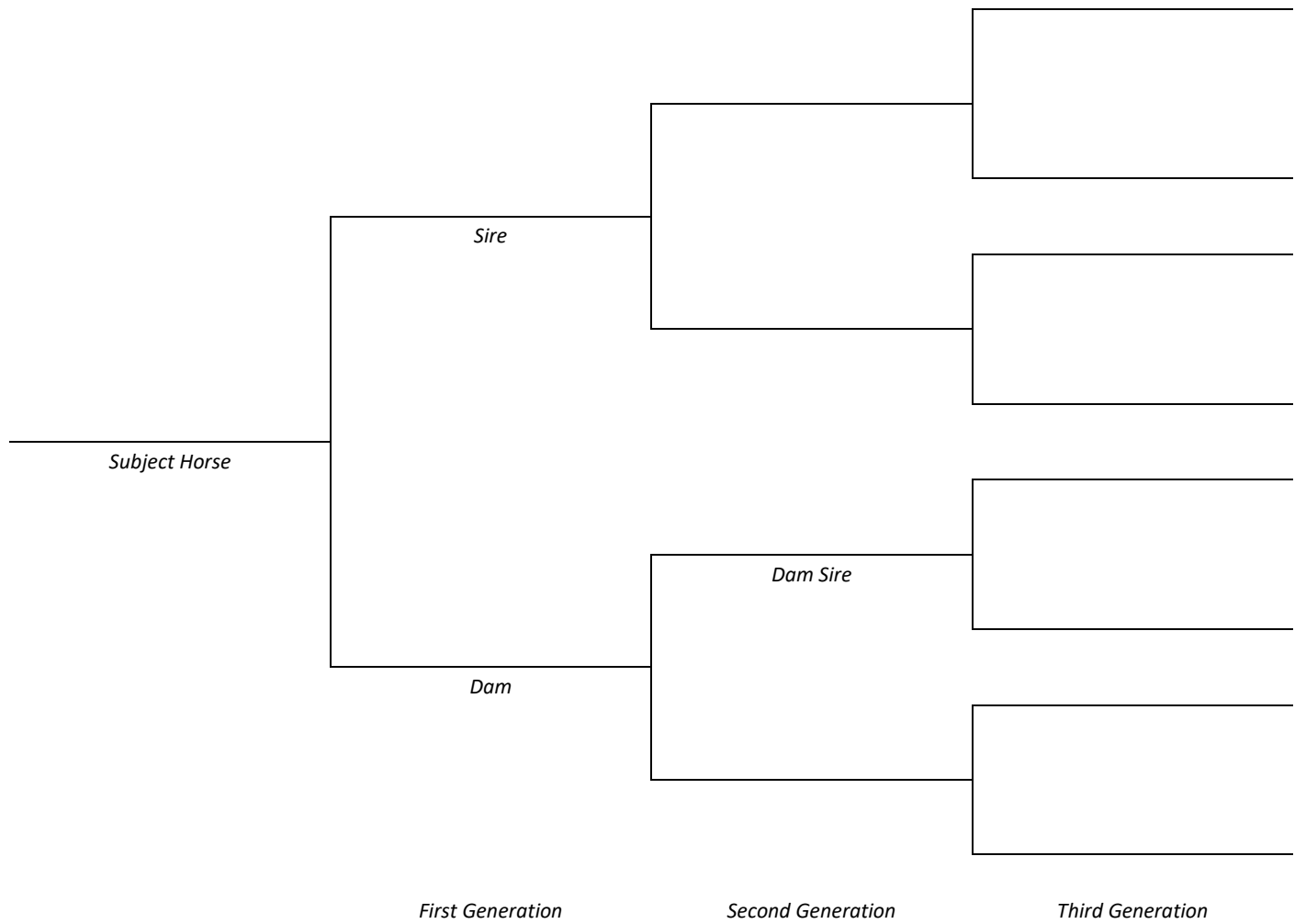

# Equestrian Victoria - Special Conditions of Entry

## Applicable Equestrian Australia (EA) documents and requirements

1. This Equestrian Victoria (EV) event is governed by the Equestrian Australia (EA) General Regulations, applicable EA Sports Rules and all relevant EA Codes, policies, bylaws, rules and regulations. The EA Sports rules (i.e. the National Rules for each EA sport or discipline) and regulations may be accessed on the EA website "Discipline Rules & Regulations" page via the following link <http://www.equestrian.org.au/rules>. The EA Codes, Policies etc. may be accessed on the EA website "Policies & Bylaws" page via the following link <http://www.equestrian.org.au/policies>.
2. To be eligible to participate in this event you must be a current EV member or current member of an EA state branch. You must also satisfy any further membership or registration requirement (including those for any horse entered) referred to in the General Conditions of Entry for the event (**Conditions of Entry**) and individual disciplines.
3. The EA National Sports Rules applicable to the event are referred to in the Conditions of Entry.
4. All EA and EV events are subject to the EA Code of Conduct (**Code of Conduct**). The Code of Conduct can be accessed on the EA website via the following link [http://www.equestrian.org.au/sites/default/files/Equestrian\\_Australia\\_Code\\_of\\_Conduct.pdf](http://www.equestrian.org.au/sites/default/files/Equestrian_Australia_Code_of_Conduct.pdf)  
It is important that all members understand that the Code of Conduct also covers parents, guardians and spectators in respect of any activity held or sanctioned by EV or an EA state branch. A key aim of the Code of Conduct is to respect the rights of everyone involved, to abide by all EA rules and requirements, to be fair, considerate, honest and professional in all aspects of the sport.
5. EA and EV are committed to the protection and welfare of its members. The EA Member Protection Policy (**MPP**) can be accessed on its website via the following link [http://www.equestrian.org.au/sites/default/files/Equestrian\\_Australia\\_Member\\_Protection\\_Policy\\_updated05072017.pdf](http://www.equestrian.org.au/sites/default/files/Equestrian_Australia_Member_Protection_Policy_updated05072017.pdf). These are important documents designed to ensure the safe and fair conduct of the event for everyone involved. They should be read, understood and complied with.
6. EA and EV events are also subject to various codes and regulations designed to protect the horse, the welfare of which is paramount (**Horse Welfare Provisions**). Entrants and Competitors must familiarise themselves with the Horse Welfare Provisions and ensure that they are complied with. These Provisions may be accessed on the EA website via the following link <http://www.equestrian.org.au/policies>.
7. If the event is conducted at Werribee Park National Equestrian Centre (WPNEC) the WPNEC Risk Management Conditions shall apply to the event. The Risk Management Conditions can be accessed via the following link <http://wpnec.com.au/risk-management/>.

## Entrants and Competitors bound by EA documents

8. Entrants and Competitors must familiarise themselves with the provisions of the EA documents referred to above (**EA documents**) and ensure that they comply with them.
9. By submitting an entry for the event you agree to comply with and be bound by the provisions of the EA documents, these Special Conditions and the Conditions of Entry.
10. If you are the parent or guardian of a participant or competitor under the age of 18 years, by submitting an entry for the event you consent to their participation in the event and undertake to the best of your ability to ensure that they understand and comply with the provisions of the EA documents, these Special Conditions and The Conditions of Entry.
11. If there is any conflict in the interpretation between the provisions of the General Regulations and any of the EA documents, these Special Conditions or the Conditions of Entry, the General

Regulations will take precedence. If there is any conflict in the interpretation between the provisions of these Special Conditions and the Conditions of Entry, the Special Conditions will take precedence.

### **Organising Committee**

12. The Organising Committee for the event is referred to in the Conditions of Entry. The Organising Committee may at its absolute discretion, decline to receive any entry or return any fee without being liable for any compensation: General Regulation, Article 116.11. The Organising Committee's decision in relation to any entry for the event shall be final and binding.

### **Cancellation and Refund**

13. EV or the Organising Committee may cancel the event due to catastrophic conditions, disease or force majeure, or for any other reason at its absolute discretion.
14. If the event is cancelled after it has commenced there will be no refunds. If the event is cancelled prior to commencement the entrant may be entitled to a proportional refund of the entry fees paid. Any such refund will be determined at the absolute discretion of EV, having regard to the direct or fixed costs for the event.
15. Entrants who have provided with their entry an email address and/or mobile phone number will be notified of event cancellation by email and/or text message.
16. The refund policy for withdrawal, scratching or change of an entry is set out in the Conditions of Entry.

### **Release and Indemnity**

17. You acknowledge that horse riding, working with or being around horses can be dangerous. Horses can act in sudden and unpredictable ways, especially if frightened or hurt. As a consequence, there is a real risk of damage to property, serious injury or even death. In consideration of acceptance of your entry and participation in the event you agree to release and forever discharge EA, EV, their servants and agents and the Organising Committee and each member thereof from all claims, proceedings or demands for any loss or damage howsoever arising from any accident or incident occurring at the event.
18. In consideration of acceptance of your entry and participation in the event, you agree to indemnify and keep indemnified EA, EV, their servants and agents and the Organising Committee and each member thereof against all claims, proceedings or demands brought by or on behalf of any participant or competitor named in your entry form for any loss or damage howsoever arising from any accident or incident occurring at the event.



## FEI CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) requires all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. The FEI urges all those involved in equestrian sport to attain the highest possible levels of education in their areas of expertise relevant to the care and management of the competition horse.

## Risk Management Conditions

1. Werribee Park National Equestrian Centre Committee of Management considers it a privilege that you are allowed to bring your dog to this venue. We insist you keep your dog under effective control at all times.
2. Approved Safety Helmets must be worn at all times when riding
3. Cross Country obstacles must not be jumped/used unless a non-riding level one coach is present.
4. Riding of horses bareback is prohibited
5. Riding of rugged and/or unbridled horses is prohibited
6. Any person may lead a maximum of two horses while mounted
7. Stallions must have an adult handler in the vicinity at all times
8. Horses are not permitted within/upon the quadrangle (between the barn & Indoor 1)
9. Horses are not permitted near pedestrian door ways
10. Bicycles are not permitted in the Indoor Arenas or any stable block. Approved helmets must be worn at all times
11. Bicycles are not permitted near doors designated as public entrances or exits
12. Motor Cyclist riders must wear approved safety helmets and hold the appropriate licence
13. Speed limits must be adhered to at all times, the speed limit at WPNEC is 10km p/h
14. Power leads must not be on the ground or over roadways
15. Construction of portable/tape yards is prohibited
16. Alcohol must not be consumed in the Indoor Arenas, unless purchased from the licensed bar located in Indoor Arena No 1
17. Please observe all signs at the venue
18. Horses must be tied in a safe manner. Horses must not be tied to unattached floats, wheelie bins etc
19. No infrastructure to be erected on WPNEC Grounds without written approval by management prior to event
20. Entry and Exit doors to Indoors Arenas are not be obstructed at any time
21. Every event to book at WPNEC must provide their own first aid officials

These conditions apply unless the Manager or the Committee of Management has given the discipline/event/activity concerned an exemption.

**\*Exemptions must be applied for in writing and will be only valid for the dates granted.\***
